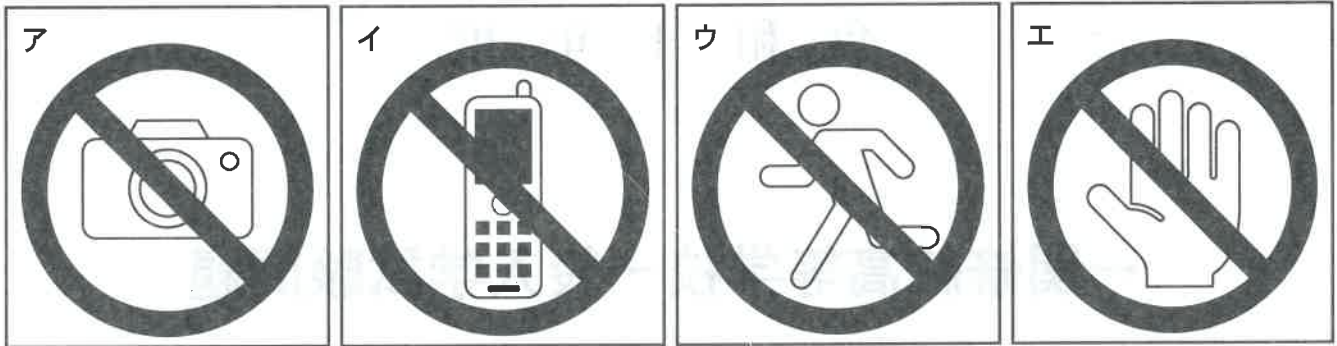

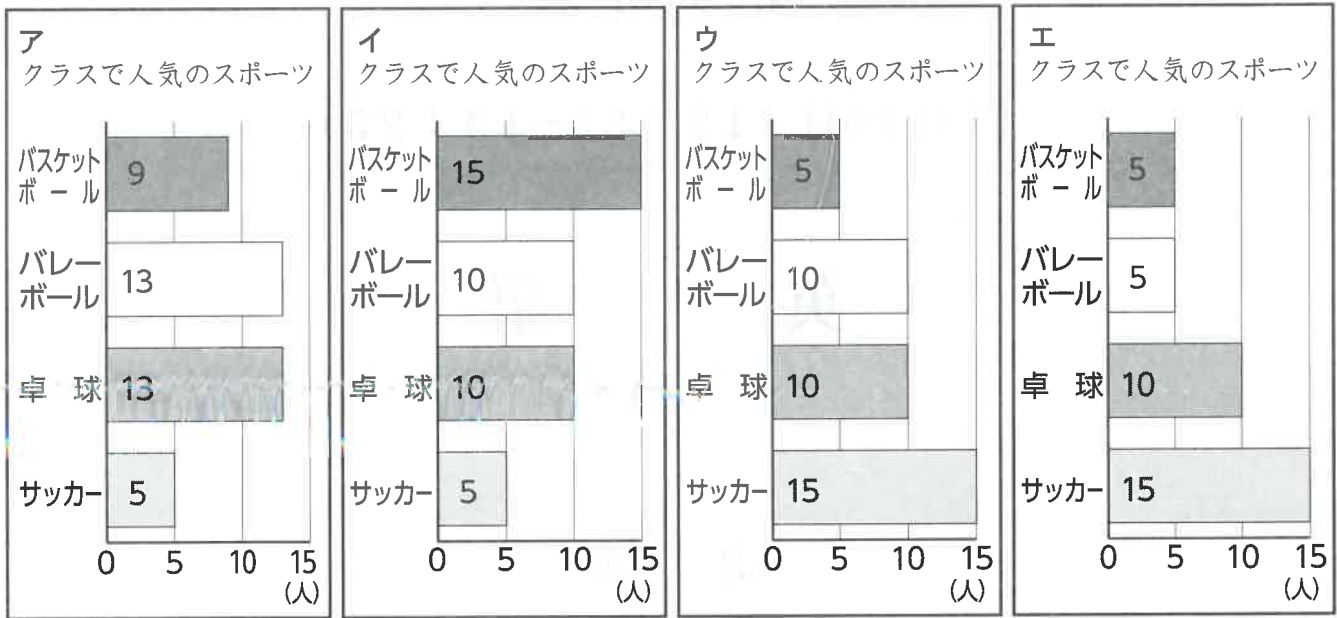

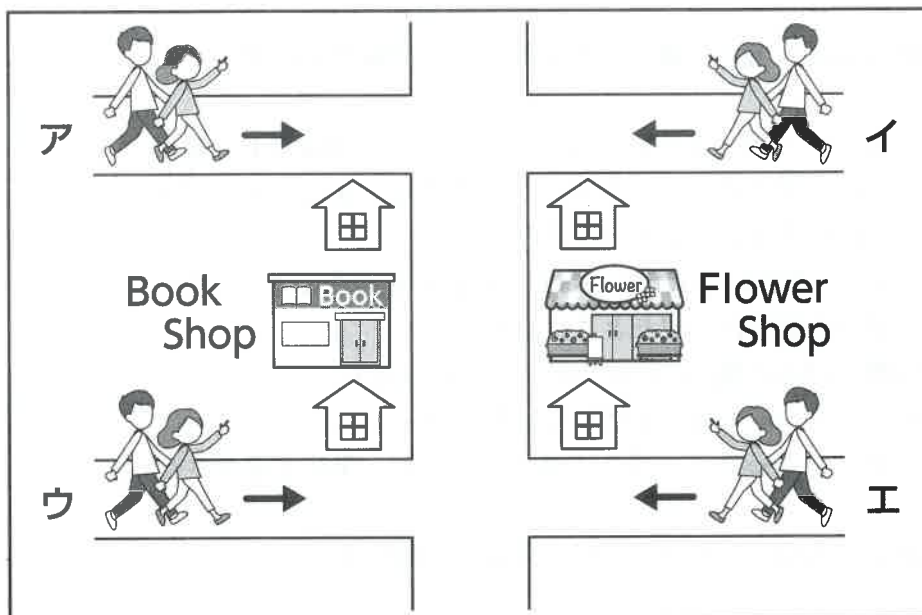

Last year Tokyo had the Olympic Games. It had *been postponed for one year because of the *Coronavirus pandemic, but it was a wonderful event for many people. It was the first time Tokyo had the Olympic Games since 1964. The Olympic Games had (1) many special points.

In 2013 the *IOC decided to have the Olympics in Tokyo, two years after the Great East Japan Earthquake. Because of the earthquake, there were tsunami and an accident at a *nuclear power plant in Fukushima. Many people thought that the Olympics would help the people of Tohoku. The Olympic Torch Relay started in Fukushima and also went through Miyagi and Iwate.

The Olympics were going to be held from July 24 to August 9, 2020, but on March 24 it was said that they would be postponed. Some people thought the Olympics should be cancelled because they cost too much money. However, the Olympics were not cancelled, and this was the first time in history that the Olympics had been postponed. They were held from July 23 to August 8, 2021.

(2) Another point about these Olympics is that only a few *spectators were able to watch the events *in person. First, in March 2021 spectators from *overseas were told they could not visit Japan to see the Olympics. Many foreigners had tickets, but now they could not use them. Then in July Japanese spectators were also told that they could not see the Olympics in person for most of the events. Most people had to watch the Olympics on television. Most of the time, athletes performed in front of few spectators.

But (3) some good things also happened. Several new events began at these Olympics. For example, three-on-three basketball and freestyle BMX were added. Japan could add sports for their Olympic Games, and added karate, sport climbing, surfing, and skateboarding.

(4) The best point for Japan was the number of medals which Japanese athletes won. They won 27 gold medals, the most for Japan, and 58 medals in total. Japan's strongest sport is judo, and they won 9 gold medals, 2 silver medals, and 1 bronze medal, *including a gold medal won by Aaron Wolf, whose mother is Japanese and father is American. It was also exciting to see Yuto Horigome and Momiji Nishiya, who was only 13 years old, win gold medals in skateboarding.

If you want to see more Olympic Games, you will not have to wait for long. The 2022 Winter Olympics in China will start next (5) m _____.
